Transcript Notes may reference courses, term/cumulative statistics, academic standing, honors and achievements--including graduation honors, and other academic information.

Grade Point Average

NDSU's GPA is calculated by dividing the total number of honor points earned by the total number of credit hours(units) in which honor points were recorded.

Tri-College

Tri-College is a consortium comprised of NDSU, Minnesota State University Moorhead, and Concordia College. Grades are calculated in the home institution's GPA only.

Academic Forgiveness

Courses and grades for the selected terms remain on the academic record, but are excluded from GPA calculations. Excluded courses cannot be used to satisfy any academic requirements.

Repeated Courses

Indicated in Notes, only the last enrollment of a repeated course is included in the GPA.

Historical Records (typically if last term of attendance was prior to Fall 2002) include:

- parentheses () around credits excluded from GPA calculations, with the exception of F grades
- asterisks (*) to reference grading footnotes
- 'Z' indicators to note repeated courses; excluded from GPA calculations.

Academic Record by Career and Last Term of Attendance*

Beginning Fall 2005: Credits and coursework are posted on Undergraduate, Graduate or Continuing Education academic records, based on student's career level.*

Academic Status

To maintain good academic standing, the following standards must be maintained:

1.75 GPA=Freshman; 1.90 GPA=Sophomore; 2.00 GPA=Junior and Senior

Undergraduate students with at least 12 credits (units) that carry honor points (nine during the summer) and earn a term GPA of 3.60 are placed on the Dean's List. Academic Probation or Continued Probation results when institutional GPA is below minimum standards for the student's classification. Academic suspension is issued when an academically deficient student does not demonstrate improvement in his/her institutional GPA. An extended-semester contract may be issued once for eligible students. Prior to Fall Semester 2005, Academic Probation and Continued Probation notes appeared on the official academic record.

Undergraduate Transfer Credit

The name of transfer institutions and total credits accepted by NDSU are indicated on the official transcript. Total credits are converted to semester credits. Generally, transfer grades are not recorded, nor computed, in the cumulative GPA. *NDSU does not issue copies of transcripts received from other institutions.*

Authenticity of Transcript

Transcripts are original when printed on green security paper and bearing the signature of the University Registrar. Transcripts are not official when stamped "Issued to Student" in red ink. When photocopied, the word "copy" will appear across the face of this document.
